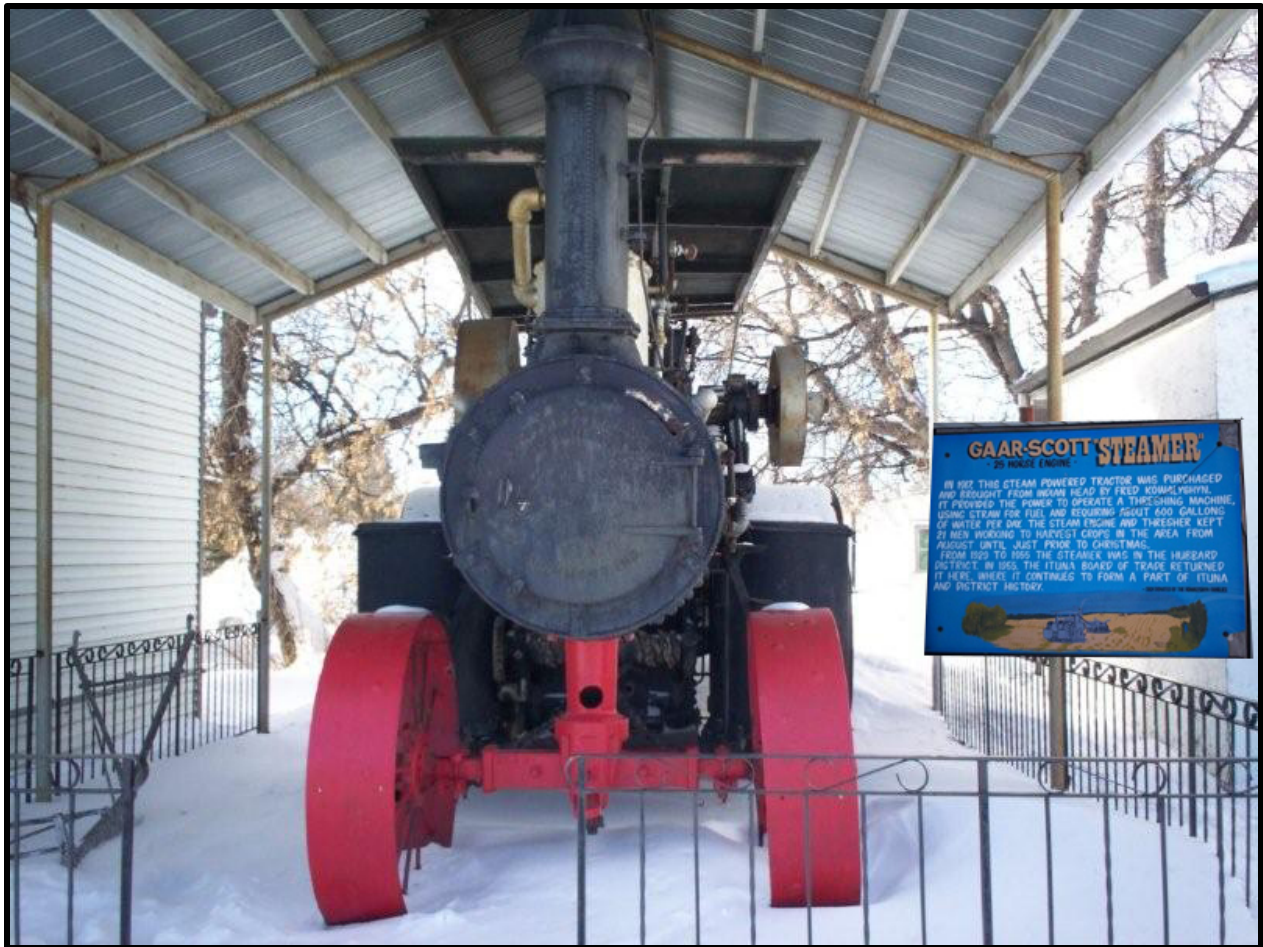


## GAAR Scott “Steamer” – 25 Horse Engine



“In 1917, this steam powered tractor was purchased and brought from Indian Head, SK by Fred Kowalyshyn. It provided the power to operate a threshing machine, using straw for fuel and requiring about 600 gallons of water per day. The steam engine and thresher kept 21 men working to harvest crops in the area from August until just before Christmas. From 1929 to 1955 the steamer was in the Hubbard, SK area. In 1955 the Ituna Board of Trade returned it here where it continues to form a part of the Ituna and district history.”
