Fall is here with all the glory of color. Harvest is continuing and we hope that the weather will remain favourable for all to finish the fall work. With fall comes leaves and refuge from gardens. Residents, if you do not have a compost pile, please take your leaves and garden refuse to the compost pile at the landfill free of charge. If doing so, we ask that it is not contained in plastic bags.

Well – Work to connect the new well has started and will continue for the next while. We were able to secure more funding to replace some well used pumps, baffles, header, etc. in the water treatment plant. By the new year, all work will be completed.

Landfill - With fall, comes new fall hours at the landfill. Commencing October 1st, 2015 Wednesdays, 12 Noon to 6:00 pm; Saturday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Winter hours at the landfill begin on November 1st and continue to April 30th; Saturday 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Water & Sewer - Just a reminder to all water and sewer users to please check for running toilets or other water leaks as a large amount of water can go through your meter in a very short period of time. One way to check for a leak is take a read of your water meter right before you are going to bed for the night. First thing the next morning, before any water is consumed take another read of your water meter. If there is no consumption, the read will be the same as the read taken the previous evening. If there is consumption, you have a leak and it should be repaired.
