The reasons for designation as stated on the Designation Bylaw are as follows:

The cemetery is over 100 years old. It represents the first Jewish colonies created to develop the North West Territories now known as Saskatchewan. The cemetery has unique features which are not found in most Jewish cemeteries and speaks of its age and Romanian tradition.
