BYLAW NO. 12-2006^a

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 12-97 NOISE BYLAW

Section 8 *The Municipalities Act*

The Council of the Town of Ituna, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 12-97, a bylaw to prohibit certain activities creating noise and to abate the incidence of noise and to restrict the hours when certain sounds may be made, adopted on September 16, 1997, is amended:

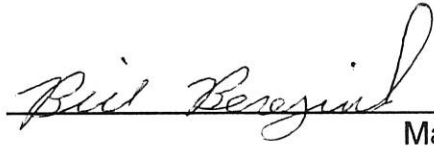
(a) in Section 2 by adding item (h) as follows:

(h) "engine brake" means a device used in trucks and semi-trailer units to slow or brake the said vehicles by means of closing the exhaust valves on the engines of the vehicles, or any similar device.

(b) after Section 9, by adding Section 9.1 as follows:

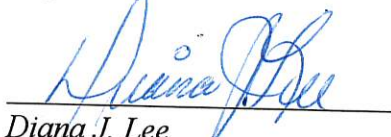
9.1 No person shall engage, operate, apply or otherwise use an engine brake on any vehicle while being driven within the Town of Ituna except in an emergency where it is necessary in the circumstance to do so.
